

# Minimum Technology Recommendations

The Tilman J. Fertitta Family College of Medicine uses a technology-rich curriculum. We make the following recommendations with student success in mind.

**You will need a laptop computer and a smartphone.**

**Recommendation: Laptop Computer:**

Any midmarket laptop computer (MAC or Windows) **newer than 2 years** should be able to support your medical school activities. We do **not recommend purchasing a tablet** (MAC-IOS or Android), netbook, or Chromebook because you cannot take exams on them. Students in the College of Medicine may be eligible for financial aid budget adjustments to cover the purchase of a computer. <b>Processor (CPU)</b>	Newer generation Intel (gen 13-14) or Apple M1-M2-M3	
<b>RAM</b>	Minimum 8 GB ( <b>get the most RAM you can afford</b> )	
<b>Hard Disk</b>	250 GB	
<b>Display</b>	1080p	
<b>Networking</b>	Wireless (2.4 and 5 GHz)	
<b>Warranty</b>	3 years or more	
<b>Operating System</b>	Windows 11, Current Mac OSX Ventura 13.x or newer)	
<b>Home Internet</b>	Broadband internet access, minimum download of 7 Mbps	
<b>Browser</b>	Google Chrome and Firefox Browsers are recommended for academic tasks.	

## Student Responsibilities:

### You will need a computer that meets the minimum requirements for:

- Accessing and downloading course files (documents, presentations, videos, etc.)
- Uploading assignment files (documents, presentations, videos, etc.)
- Taking Quizzes and Exams
- Posting to Discussion Boards
- Accessing resources through different browsers
- Taking notes / annotating resources
- Presenting student-created files/media through an external data projector.

### You will need a Smartphone that can:

- Install study resources apps and UH authentication apps
- Responding to class questions using a browser or an app.

### General Recommendations:

Use your UH credentials to access Office.com and your MS- OneDrive to backup your files and collaborate with other students and faculty (you will have 1 TB of Cloud storage).

### Computer Accessories:

- A 1 TB or greater external drive. Back up your school-related files often. (Computers can and will fail)
- Always connect your charger for exams (Have an extra charging cable for your laptop)
- A webcam is required for online meetings (built-in on most laptops)
- Headphones and earbuds to avoid noise and feedback during online meetings.
- HDMI and USB-C to USB-A adapter (also available for lending at the library)
