<b>Job Description</b>	The Substance Use Counselor will work to serve the behavioral health needs of the patients of AccessHealth and serve as integral member of the Behavioral Health Integration Team (BHI Team). The Substance Use Counselor will work collaboratively with an integrated team of professionals, including physicians, psychiatrists, nurse practitioners, medical assistants, nurses, and on-site behavioral health staff. The Substance Use Counselor will assess patients' behavioral health needs, provide substance use prevention education, conduct screenings/brief interventions during and/or after medical appointments, and provide individual and group counseling. The Substance Use Counselor will refer patients with moderate to severe behavioral health needs to onsite behavioral health team or community mental health institutions; as well as refer patients with moderate to severe substance use to the onsite Medication Assisted Treatment program or to community partners specializing in detox, intensive outpatient and residential treatment facilities.
